

Positive Behavioral Interventions and Supports (PBIS) Training

Presenters will include consultants from Region 8 State Support Team.

Description:

PBIS is a framework or approach for assisting school personnel in adopting and organizing evidence-based behavioral interventions into an integrated continuum that enhances academic and social behavior outcomes for all students.

PBIS IS NOT a packaged curriculum, scripted intervention, or manualized strategy. PBIS IS a prevention-oriented way for school personnel to (a) organize evidence-based practices, (b) improve their implementation of those practices, and (c) maximize academic and social behavior outcomes for students. PBIS supports the success of ALL students (PBIS.org).

This training will teach building teams to create and implement the Universal Tier (Tier 1) of a PBIS framework. Building teams will learn the rationale for implementing this framework. In addition, teams will understand the development of school-wide expectations which will be used in their buildings. Teams will also learn about systems of reinforcement and data systems that can inform decision making and help monitor behaviors at the building level. This is a 2 day compacted training intended to give participants all of the foundational knowledge to develop a universal system of support. There will be no planning time during these sessions.

Participants will:

- Identify the rationale for implementing PBIS
- Understand aspects of the PBIS framework
- Understand overarching expectations and determine how they will be taught to students
- Understand reinforcement systems and systematic plan for error correction
- Identify a data management system to monitor behaviors
- Identify resources for PBIS at the state and national level
